

Explaining Music 8: Major Scales – Part 2

In the last lesson we looked at the pattern of tones and semitones in a major scale.




We learned that a major scale is made of 2 tetrachords (each is tone-tone-semitone) joined by a tone.

Here's an example starting on C#:




1. Mark the notes of the major scale starting on D on the keyboard diagram below.


