Explaining Music 9: Sharp Key Signatures – part 2

In the last lesson we learned that the order of **sharps** in a key signature is:

Father Charles Goes Down And Ends Battle

The **sharps** always appear like this on the **grand staff**




So how do we figure out what **key** the music is in?

If you've played a lot of scales you probably already know the sharps and flats in those scales.

We can also figure out the **key** from the **sharps** in the **key signature** (We're looking at **major keys** only.)

Here's the rule:

- Find the last **sharp** in the **key signature**
- Go up a semitone from that sharp and that's your major key
